<u>DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED</u>: A valid passport is required to enter Argentina and Chile. Please check the validity dates on your passport and verify that it does not expire prior to or *WITHIN SIX MONTHS* from the date of your return to your home city. If your passport expires before November 6, 2017, you must have your passport renewed *PRIOR* to this trip. Please refer to the General information tab for passport renewal instructions.

FINAL DOCUMENTS: Approximately three weeks prior to departure, you will receive an 2-day express package which will include more detailed information regarding the trip, travel documents, luggage tags, name badges, leave behind emergency contact information cards, and a dress grid.

NSD TRIP CANCELLATION: Please refer to the cancellation policy on the General Information tab found on the homepage of the website, and for further information you can refer to the NSD Guide.

GENERAL INFORMATION: MARY KAY is paying for all services rendered in connection with your planned itinerary. This includes ground transportation on group travel days, hotel accommodations, meals as outlined in the trip schedule of events agenda, baggage handling, transfers and all gratuities for these services.
